

On behalf of the Board of Directors, employees, volunteers and, most importantly, the residents of Green Doors, please accept my sincere gratitude for the investment of clothing and toiletries that you valued at \$125.00. This investment will impact the wellbeing of people exiting homeless who are working diligently to achieve housing stability and greater self-sufficiency.

Founded in 1990 by a formerly homeless young woman, Green Doors' mission is transform lives and communities in Central Texas. Green Doors accomplishes this by: creating affordable, safe, quality housing; providing residents with access to supportive services; and educating about, and advocating for, individuals and families struggling with homelessness and at-risk for homelessness. Every night over 2,300 Travis County residents spend the night outside of permanent shelter - nearly 40 percent are homeless families.

The impact made by stable, supportive housing is powerful. One resident at our Pecan Springs Commons community now lives in a furnished home after 11 years spent living on the streets and in shelters. He describes his life in this Green Doors community as a "brand new start" that gives him "the peace of mind to make plans, and set goals to achieve a decent life." A recent graduate from our rental assistance program describes herself as "dignified, empowered and whole," and is now studying at ACC.

We are very pleased to report to you that the programs of Green Doors have resulted in over 1000 formerly homeless people attaining independence and permanent housing in Austin.
